Framecore (Pty) Ltd. undertook the Scatec Solar fit out and upgrade in the Waterway House building situated at the V&A Waterfront in 2020 after the national COVID 19 lockdown. This second phase fit out would add much needed space of approximately 300m2 to Scatec's growing operations after the initial fit out in 2017 of approximately 2000m2 of office space from a grey box floor plate situated on the 2nd storey of the building.







Amongst other things, logics management and building methodology were crucial to ensure landlord and tenant expectations were taken into account while working around the clock to achieve a tight handover date.

The construction works were competed over a 5-month period, which included specialist finishes, ceilings and bulkheads (with acoustic Ecophon panels), acoustic doors and aluminium installations, electrical, plumbing, fire and mechanical installations amongst other.
